




REGULATION



The area called “CAORLE BAU BEACH” is an equipped and delimited part of beach made available for guests accompanied by their pets. The use of this portion of the beach is subject to the following rules and regulations.

This regulation has been created according to the following applicable Italian laws:

Legge Regionale 23 febbraio 2016, n. 7 Legge di stabilità regionale 2016, Modifiche all’articolo 18 bis della legge regionale 28 dicembre 1993, n. 60 Tutela degli animali d’affezione e prevenzione del randagismo.

Ordinanza 3 marzo 2009 Ministero del Lavoro della Salute e delle Politiche Sociali. Articolo 1, commi 1, 2, 3 e 4 – ordinanza contingibile ed urgente concernente Tutela dell’incolumità pubblica dell’aggressione di cani (G.U. n. 68 del 23.03.2009).

ACCESS AND USE

It is possible to enter the area during the opening hours of the beach as specified in the applicable DECREE OF BEACH SECURITY as follows.

The access is allowed only to those in possession of a receipt released by the beach staff or in possession of the coupon “Bau Beach” (accurately filled and signed) released by one of the hotels/agencies affiliated to Consorzio Arenili Caorle or to those owning all the requirement specified below.

The receipt and the documents testifying the hygienically and healthy conditions of the pet have to be given to the manager of the facility to let him/her control the validity. The manager will eventually verify the observance of all the other requirements.

The lack of documentation and requirements as specified above will authorize the staff to forbid the access to the area to his incontestable discretion.

It is forbidden to conduct the pets outside the equipped area, which is identified and delimited by enclosures and accessible through the indicated path, or outside the waters situated in front of the beach (signalled with buoys).

EQUIPMENT

The following standard beach equipment is given to the guests: a beach umbrella, two sun beds. Masters have the task to provide to their pets wellbeing, ensuring that they are well positioned in the shadows.

Guests are also supplied of a water bowl; moreover there is a shower dedicated to pets.

Consorzio Arenili provides guests with bags and a small shovel available through a vending machine or by asking the staff.

To ensure the hygiene and healthiness of the beach the Consortium guarantees periodical interventions to clean up the area.

REQUIREMENTS

To access and benefit from the services of Bau Beach all the pets have to fulfil the hygienic rules, as for example vaccinations required by the applicable Italian law. In particular:

- Dogs have to be identified with a microchip or tattoo and fitted of valid health book;
- Anti rabies vaccination is mandatory for dogs, cats and ferrets from abroad and in any case it has to be made at least 21 days before;
- Entry is forbidden to dogs with aggressive syndrome and to females in season;
- The master has to carry with him the documents that guarantee the periodical vaccinations against the main infective diseases (distemper, leptospirosis, parvovirosis) and parasites;
- It is forbidden to carry to the beach dogs with cardiovascular diseases.

BEHAVIOUR

People have to carry the dog to the Bau Beach by the leash. The leash has to be maximum 1,50 mt long and the pet has to be kept by the leash even when stationary.

The dog has to wear a collar against fleas or has to be treated with anti-parasitic.

The solid dog faeces have to be promptly collected and thrown in the proper trash bins.

The liquid dog faeces have to be cleaned using abundant water.

The dog owners must avoid – however possible – long woofs or excessively lively dog behaviours; otherwise the staff could decide to his incontestable discretion to ask them to leave.

The dog owner has to keep with him a stiff or soft muzzle that has to be used in case of risks for people or other pets' safety upon request by the authorities. (As for art. 3b - Ordinanza 3 marzo 2009 Ministero del Lavoro della Salute e delle Politiche Sociali).

The dog has always to be under the control of its master, for this reason it is not allowed to leave pets alone, uncontrolled or free to go around.

Bathing is allowed only to 5 dogs at a time in the area delimited by buoys. The master has to accompany the dog in the water and, at the end of the bath, the dog has to be leashed again.

RESPONSIBILITIES

The user completely takes on all the civil and penal responsibilities connected to the behaviour of its own pet, declaring from now on to relieve the Consorzio from every obligation, cost, duty, expense or compensation in case the pet should cause damages to people and/or things caused – directly or indirectly – by his own pet.

CONSORZIO PER LO SVILUPPO E LA GESTIONE DEGLI ARENILI DELLA MARINA DI CAORLE SRL, in any case, declines from now on every responsibility for accidents or damages to people and/or things caused by impudence or lack of respect for the regulation and/or laws.
